

2016 Men's Pennant
Weather and the weekend of 3-4 September
Alternative arrangements
In case of bad weather

On Tuesday evening, the weather forecast for Saturday 3 September 2016 was "rain clearing – with High chance (80%) of 8 to 10 ml most likely in the morning with a chance of a morning thunder storm.

Results of one or more games in Divisions 1, 3, 4 & 5 can have an effect on either the top three or the relegation spot or both.

District men's match committee, as controlling body, has determined in accordance with CoP cl 13 that:

'Divisions 1, 3, 4 and 5

*For games scheduled for Saturday 3 September 2016, **all Division 1, 3, 4 and 5 sides** MUST endeavour to complete game or at least enough ends (50) to declare a result on that day.*

In the event of any game being washed out or abandoned, the game MUST be rescheduled for Sunday 4 September.

If Sunday play is required, the starting time may be by mutual consent. In the absence of agreement the starting time shall be 1pm.

Failure to comply will result in no points being awarded.

Divisions 2 and 6

For Division 2 and 6 preliminary final games, any washed out or abandoned game will transfer to Sunday 4 September in the same time slots.

Failure to do so result in the offending team being forfeited.
